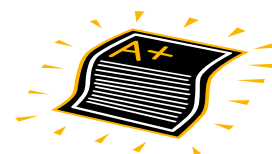

PSAT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test) is a standardized test that measures critical reading skills, math problem solving, and writing skills important for success in college. The PSAT provides first hand practice for the SAT Reasoning Test.

Hebron pays for all sophomores to take the PSAT. The test is given on October 14th; there is no makeup date.

Student scores can be used as a diagnostic tool by both parents and students to identify strengths and weaknesses.
